CANADA

Icewine

Icewine is a type of dessert wine produced from grapes that have been frozen while still on the vine. The sugars and other dissolved solids do not freeze, but the water does, allowing for a more concentrated wine to develop. Canada is the world's largest producer of ice wines, producing a greater volume of ice wine than all other countries combined, followed by Germany.

Bordeaux

Sauternes wine is made from Sémillon, Sauvignon Blanc, and Muscadelle grapes. The Sauternes wine region comprises five communes - Barsac, Sauternes, Bommes, Fargues and Preignac. While all five communes are permitted to use the name Sauternes, the Barsac region is also permitted to label their wines under the Barsac appellation.

Eiswein

(Ice-wine) The grapes are left to shrivel on the vines. They must reach the same level of sugar concentration as Beerenauslese. They cannot be picked until after the temperature reaches 20 degrees. The grapes are pressed while frozen, resulting in a very sweet wine.

HUNGARY

The Hungarian word 'Aszu' means 'candied', the grapes affected by the Botrytis Cinerea with a high sugar content are picked manually. Tokaji Aszu is only made in prime years, and its sweetness is measured in Puttonyos. Measurements range from 3 to 6 Puttonyos. A Tokaji made entirely from Aszú grapes is not labeled using the Puttonyos system but is known as Eszencia. Also called nectar, Eszencia or Essencia is often described as one of the most exclusive wines in the world.
